

Summary of PLBC COVID Safe Guidelines – Effective 9 December 2020

General

1. **PLBC Members** are permitted to use the Clubhouse and Club facilities and you are welcome to invite guests as per normal PLBC policy (4 guests per member family). Please ensure guests use the QR code AND are signed in the guest book at the front door.
2. If you or anyone in your household has **any COVID symptoms** (or possible symptoms), please do not use the Clubhouse or Club facilities or participate in Club activities.
3. Please comply with the **Victorian Government COVID safe regulations** at all times whilst you are at the Club, in particular:
 - Social distance (1.5metres, other than with family members)
 - It is recommended a facemask be worn when social distancing cannot be maintained
 - Wash and sanitise your hands regularly
 - Avoid interactions in close spaces

Using the Clubhouse to be COVID safe

4. Please **register yourself and all family members and guests** at the start of every visit to the Clubhouse. You will find the register and QR code beside the main door.
5. The kitchen will be open for use when Duty Officers are rostered on to ensure full cleaning takes place
 - You may use the fridge at any time, please wipe clean surfaces/handles with disinfectant wipes provided by the Club after use
 - Hours for December use of kitchen are:
 - i. Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday evenings 5.30pm -8.30pm
 - ii. All Saturday and Sunday
 - iii. 21-24 December 12 noon – 3pm
 - If you wish to use the BBQ outside kitchen hours, we will require you to bring all your utensils and take them home to clean them please.
 - We do encourage members and their guests to bring their own paper plates and utensils where possible please. Please ensure you wash all PLBC dishes etc in the dishwasher.
6. Please wipe down any tables, chairs, surfaces after use with disinfectant wipes provided by the Club for this purpose.
7. All **doors to the Clubhouse must remain closed** and locked at all times. Please ensure you carry your key at all times.
8. Please accept the **guidance of the Duty Officer(s)** when they are on duty during peak times: help them by respecting these guidelines.
9. Please limit the number of Members in the Clubhouse as follows:
 - Upper deck (outside): 50
 - Upstairs (including in the kitchen area): 40
 - Lower deck near ramp (outside): 30
 - Lower back deck (near driveway): 20
