

#### **BOAT DECK POLICY**

Rev 26.05.2014

There is limited space available for storing boats and watercraft at the Point Leo Boat Club ("Boat Club") and the Boat Club cannot guarantee that space will be available for a particular boat, watercraft and other equipment. Preference for storage will be given to active sailors at the Boat Club.

Large watercraft such as long surf skis, kayaks will be considered boats and storage fees are applicable, according to the current "Boat and Watercraft Storage Fee Schedule".

## **Applications**

If you would like to store a boat or other large/long equipment at the Boat Club you must make application for authorisation to the Committee, Rear Commodore or delegated representative via the "Application Form For Storage Of Boats and Watercraft". Applications have to be remade **each year.** 

## **Conditions of Storage**

Boats and equipment are stored subject to the following terms:

- Application for storage must be made each year.
- ❖ Only current paid up members may store boats or equipment.
- All applicable storage fees (as determined by the Committee of Management on an annual basis) must be paid.
- ❖ Boats and equipment must be maintained in good working order.
- Members are responsible for their own insurance.
- ❖ Storage rights are non-transferable. Storage is a revocable licence.
- ❖ Boats and equipment must be clearly named.
- ❖ Equipment must be stored neatly and in the applicable area.
- \* Refer also to detailed conditions on the application form.

#### Removal

The Boat Club reserves the right to remove and dispose of any boat, watercraft or other equipment that is *unnamed* (or in breach of any other terms and conditions). Any boat, water craft or other extraneous equipment that is left in a dangerous or nuisance location will be removed.

## **Personal Responsibility**

Storage is at the owner's own risk.

Take care when moving your boat watercraft or equipment in and out of the Boat Deck and be mindful of other people's property.

The ramp may be hazardous and very slippery and care needs to be taken when using it.

Note: Children are the responsibility of their parents or other supervising adult and must be properly supervised in the Boat Deck, including the Rigging Deck and Ramp, at all times.

#### Winch

Only authorised and trained members may use the winch and must follow the winch operating procedure.

## **Boat Watercraft & Equipment Storage Fee Schedule**

All boats and watercraft may only be stored inside the boatdeck, outside in the yard or the rigging deck or under the boat deck when application has been made, authorisation has been given and the boat or watercraft has been included on the "Boat Storage Register". Note: all boats and watercraft must be included on the "Boat Storage Register".

Note: Kayaks, paddleboards, surfboards and sailboards **under** 2.7 metres in length also require application for storage and payment of a fee and can only be stored in designated areas or as directed by the Rear Commodore or a delegated representative. If there is no room in the designated area, then you are not to leave the watercraft in the boatdeck or yard but must take them with you when you depart.

**BOATS & LARGE WATERCRAFT** (SURFSKIS, KAYAKS & SAILBOARDS 3.5 METRES & OVER): Stored on boat racks or on floor as directed.

9.	Under 2.7 metres inside Boatdeck \$	Fee applicable - As of Oct 2014.

# Other Equipment & Items

Beach chairs may only be stored in the designated beach chair racks.

Boogie boards may only be stored in the designated racks (the lean-to room off the east rigging deck).

Do not leave any extraneous equipment, beach toys or other items in the boat deck, yard or rigging deck without express authorisation from the Rear Commodore or delegated representative.
